



## *INDIAN HILLS CRIMINAL JUSTICE CLUB*

The criminal justice department at Indian Hills Community College in conjunction with the department's student based Criminal Justice Club, is currently offering educational scholarships for students in the criminal justice program. **"The Club"** promotes campus wide and community involvement. Focusing on community improvement through various philanthropic endeavors, "The Club" encourages anyone interested to pursue higher education and give back to their communities.

The scholarship award will be in the amount of \$1000 for the year. To receive the award, the student must be enrolled full-time at Indian Hills Community College, pursuing an associate's degree in Criminal Justice and either be an active Criminal Justice Club member or willing to join the club. **To be considered for the scholarship, the student must complete a written essay. The essay should explain why the student is interested in studying criminal justice and why they deserve the scholarship. The essay should be a minimum of 300 words and be in Georgia 12 font. The final decision on awarding scholarships will be made by the criminal justice program director and program instructor(s).**

- ❖ Remember, this is a scholarship and not a grant. Scholarships are generally earned by performing at a high level and demonstrating the effort to succeed educationally. Scholarships are generally not based solely upon financial needs.

**The essay and application must be received by midnight of April 1, 2016.**
