AP COURSES

- AP Score Reports are sent in July to the college or university you designate on your answer sheet, to you, and to your high school. Each report is cumulative and includes scores for all of the AP Exams you have ever taken, unless you have requested that one or more scores be withheld from a college or cancelled.
 - **If you did not designate your scores be sent to a specific college when you tested and now need to do so, you can request your score reports be sent to colleges by calling 888-308-0013 or 609-771-7366. Please note: This is the only way to have your AP scores sent to a college.**

CONCURRENT COURSES

- If students have met all of the requirements of a concurrent course, high school credit only is indicated on the students HS transcript. The college credit is given by Kirkwood Community College and put on a Kirkwood transcript. **If a student wishes to have this credit transferred to another college or university, students must contact Kirkwood and complete an Official Transcript Request Form at the end of the year.**

CLEP EXAMINATIONS

- College Level Examination Program (CLEP) offers students an opportunity to *receive college credit* for what they already know that they may generally take in your first two years of college. By passing a CLEP exam, a student can earn 3 to 12 college credits toward a college degree, depending on the exam subject and the policy of the college. The 33 different types of CLEP examinations are administered around the state/nation at several locations.
