- 1) Check Student Pacing
 - a) K-5 students should be ready to start the day after the required day sent out by Mr Slabagh.
 - b) For example: the student below should have been thru Day 79 by the end of the week. This makes him/her ready to start Day 80 on Monday. This is ON PACE.



- c) Students who are found to be **On Pace & passing all classes will be counted present for the full 5-day week**.
- 2) Lesson requirements. If off pace, attendance will be based on the number of lessons completed the previous week.
 - This table shows the number of lessons needed to be counted present per day.

3) If students are found to be Off Pace OR <u>failing 1 or more classes</u>, they are considered Off Pace and student activity is checked to see how many lessons were completed within the attendance week. Students can be on pace within their calendar and failing classes. If this happens, they are considered Off Pace and attendance will be based on the number of lessons completed.
